## Case study: Chronic non-healing wound

- Patient history:** Diamond, a Boerperd stallion, presented with a **chronic non-healing wound** on his left front limb. He had sustained the injury, proximal to his coronary band, **22 days earlier** on a barb wire fence and had been treated appropriately. The owners, however, struggled with bandage applications, maggot infestation in the wound, and the necrotic area kept on extending with **no healing**.
- Treatment:** Light Therapy was done once a day using the **21 day + protocol**, every second or third day.
- Outcome:** Light Therapy **improved blood circulation** to the area, promoting **cellular regeneration and repair, speeding up recovery**. The stallion made a full recovery with **no proud flesh and minimal scar tissue** formation.
